We serve low-income residents of Detroit, Highland Park or Hamtramck who are:

- ✦ **Unemployed, and/or formerly incarcerated, and/or 18 – 24 year old minority males**
- ✦ **Able to pass a drug test and work legally in U.S.**
- ✦ **Eligible for WIA/WIOA funding**

All Programs Include:

- ✦ **Assessment of math and reading skills**
- ✦ **Individual coaching throughout the program**
- ✦ **Supportive services:** benefits access, work clothing, transportation help, financial coaching, etc.
- ✦ **Stipends during training**
- ✦ **Work readiness, math, reading and computer skills along with vocational training**
- ✦ **Additional supports between vocational training and job placement**
- ✦ **Job placement and ongoing supports to help you keep the job you find!**
